No smoking or vaping is allowed.
No running on the deck.
No diving from the side of the pool. Diving only
permitted in the diving well.
No loitering in the diving well. After diving and
sliding, please exit the pool so the next person
can go.
One person at a time on the slide platform and
diving board and ladder. Once the person in
front of you goes, you may then climb the
ladder/steps.
Do not use or step on starting blocks.
No items in the slide. IE: rafts, innertubes, boards,
balls, Life jackets, etc.
Please swim under the lane lines and not over
them.

No chicken fighting (sitting on shoulders) or ball
throwing in the pool.
Please listen to the lifeguard whistle. Repeated
warnings will result in dismissal from the pool.
